3 Dimensional Pinwheel Quilt Block



Instructions:

Step 1: Cutting

- 4 background squares: 3"
- 4 pinwheel squares 3"
- Make 2 for mystery quilt

Step 2: Assembling Folded Pinwheel

- 1) Cut 4 background and 4 pinwheel blocks. The only rule is that they should contrast.
- 2) Fold the pinwheel squares in half diagonally and iron.



Lay the folded triangle on top of the background fabric

Taking one point on the triangle, fold it down and pin in place



Repeat with the other pinwheels. Pay attention to which point you fold down. You want to make sure they are the same each time or your pinwheels might spin in the wrong direction.



Lay the block out and sew two together



Sew the sets together to finish the block. The center seam will be quite bulky. The finished size will be 5.5" (5" finished)

Make 2 for mystery quilt
